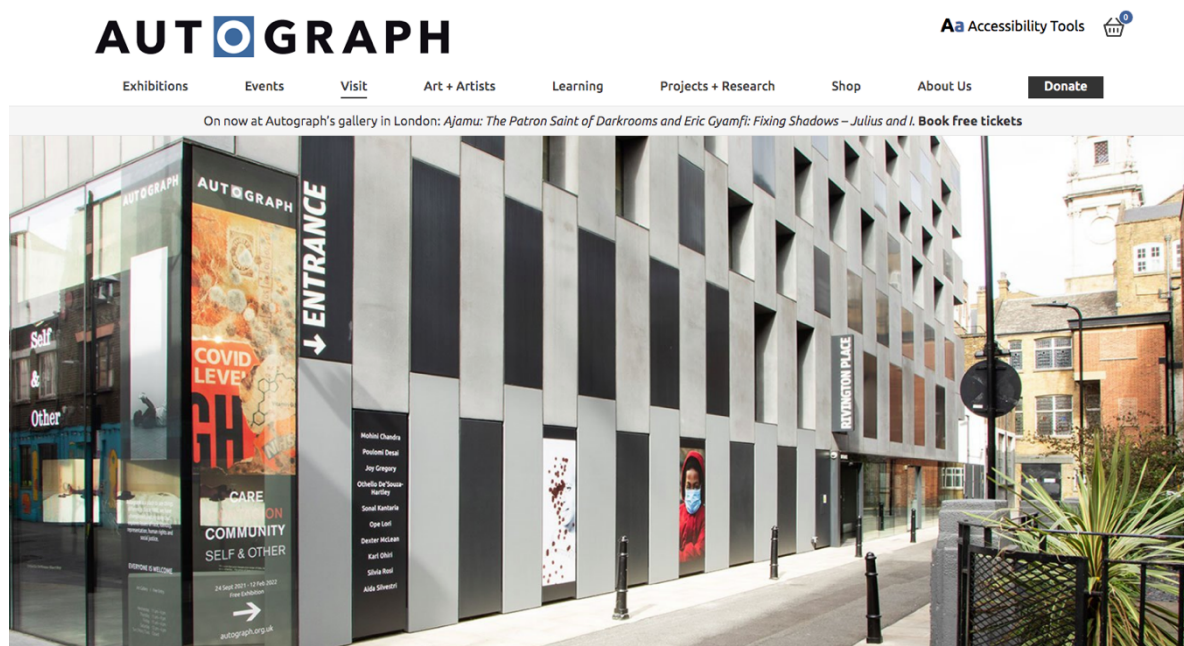

Autograph ABP is an arts charity based in Hackney who champion the work of artists who use photography and film to highlight questions of race, representation, human rights and social justice. They have a diverse photographic collection, two gallery floors with free exhibitions and a learning studio.

A Jamaican-British photographer with an acute understanding of black consciousness, his images are life-affirming moments that celebrate the resilience and survival of African diasporic cultures.
